A call has been published for the INU Prize for Urban Planning Literature, 3rd Edition, with the aim to promote the culture of urban planning, and to support activities in urban planning, urbanism and urban design theory and research. All relevant publications are eligible for the prize, which is divided in the following categories: 'Monograph', 'Contribution in a book', 'Journal article', 'Unpublished work'.

The Priz e will be given to written works from the urban planning discipline, following the rules described in the Regulations. The announcement of the winners will take place during the Third day of Urban Planning Literature in December 2014, where round tables and discussions will be organized for each prize category, curated by the members of the Scientific Committee, in which the editors of urban planning and urbanism journals will be invited to take part.

Re-forming Milan. Design experiments for neglected and decayed spaces and buildings

Triennale di Milano, Milan, Italy July 16th - August 31st, 2014

The exhibition presents more than hundred design strategies developed by the students of the School assuming the bases offered by the municipal investigation about the phenomena of abandonment and underutilization of buildings, spaces and facilities in the territory of Milan. The proposed projects deal with different intervention scales and collect the approaches of different disciplinary fields - urban planning and urbanism, architectural and urban design, technology, rehabilitation and preservation - and are oriented to outline alternative scenarios such as functional redevelopment, rehabilitation, also for temporary uses, and technological adaptation. The results represent a varied collection of solutions for the reflection on this relevant part of heritage, so important for dimension and diffusion in the city.

MIAW 2014 is a series of workshops offered by the School of Architecture and Society and promoted in collaboration with the initiative 'Re-forming Milan'. The intention is to encourage a multi-scale and interdisciplinary approach to the architectural design. MIAW 2014 is an international forum which promotes comparisons between schools, teachers and students, but it is also an informal platform to discuss issues and to share the ambitions that the learning process of architectural design involves.

In this sense the initiative follows the path of the commitm ent of the School of Architecture and Society to be a place of preparation and experimental design on the issues of the city of Milan and its metropolitan area and discussion on these issues with the public and with the civil society.

Some of the issues which are explored include bioregional dynamics, polycentric models, morphologies and typologies of the metropolitan and post-metropolitan cities; all the while, with a thorough consideration of the environmental issues, particularly the territorial ecology and the territorial policies for sustainability.

'Il progetto di Bioregione' - Società dei Territorialisti Summer School DEADLINE: Rolling, until all places are filled

Piombino, Italy

August 31st - September 7th, 2014

The Summer School organized by the Itali an Territorial Society (SdT - Società dei Territorialisti) will take place in Piombino, close to the sea of the Tuscan Region (in the Gulf of Follonica and on the Tuscan Archipelago Islands, in the South-Central part of Tuscany). The Summer School is conceived as an experimental and an educational experience based on the concept and on the project of a 'Bioregion'.

The territory that hosts the Summer School will serve as a kind of an experimental laboratory, where a new model of socio-economic development will be designed, based on enhancement of the territorial heritage. For years, the industrial development model in the region has been in decline, along with the mining sector. The school will be organized through lectures, classes and workshops. It will be tackle diverse topics though analytic, designerly and planning activities, integrating the various disciplines that are concerned with the territory.

'RhOME for denCity' Team wins the Solar Decathlon Europe 2014

Rome, Italy

The Italian team of Università degli Studi di Roma Tre wins first prize in the competition Solar Decathlon Europe 2014 in Versailles, promoted by the USA Department of Energy, beating 19 other teams and sustainable housing projects from around the world.

The project 'RhOME for denCity' aims to redevelop the peripheral area of Tor Fiscale in Rome through the construction of social housing low cost and high-performing to create tomorrow's sustainable districts in energy, socially and economically. The prototype (65 sqm) has been completely realized in wood and sustainable materials with a particular attention to the internal air quality and to the natural light illumination system.

EURAU 2014: 'Composite Cities'

European Symposium on Research in Architecture and Urban Design

The EURAU project was initiated in 2004 and it launched the proposal of an annual symposium for researchers dealing with Research in Architecture and Urbanism. The various editions were organized by different European Schools of Architecture with a coordinated effort by a broad group of university professors and researchers.

The purpose of this initiative is to enable the confrontation between researchers concerned with the Architecture and the City on the European scene. The acronym EURAU describes the congregation of the objectives which motivate these events: EU for "European Union", R for "Research", A for "Architecture" and U for "Urbanism". The seventh edition is going to be held in 2014 at the Faculty of Architecture of Istanbul Technical University.
