





Scales of visibility have changed >>> from city >>> to city region >>> metropolitan region


Competition offers new opportunities and creates new disparities

Metropolitan regions, including the small and medium-sized cities in their neighborhood tend to be the winners, small and medium-sized cities in the periphery the losers of globalization






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4 NRW Regionale Bergisches Städtedreieck

A programme (for a limited time period) of the state NRW to

- develop new regional visions
- promote regional development strategies from below
- concert urban, economic, cultural and environmental policies
- strengthen regional identity and to sharpen regional profiles
- enhance intraregional communication and cooperation beyond administrative routines



5 Why is **intraregional** Urban Co-operation so Difficult?

1. Traditions and cultural differences
2. Dependency culture
3. Institutional constraints
4. Vested political (and economic) interests and power games
5. Communication difficulties
6. Media intervention
7. Gridlocked debates on conflicting issues
8. Lack of trust and jealousy



6 Forming Strategic Urban Alliances

How?

> Aim: Creating win-win situations

1. Build trust
2. Identify local potential and tacit knowledge and competences
3. Import new networkers to organise the urban alliance
4. Formulate joint visions
5. Improve transparent communication processes
6. Design catalytic projects culture, food....
7. Involve the media and civil society in such processes
8. Give the younger generation a voice
9. Develop an ambitious time framework around events
